

CONFUSED BY DEGREE CLASSIFICATION?

The University of Worcester have two different methods for calculating an undergraduate degree with honours. The method that produces the highest Grade Point Average will be used by the University to determine your classification.

METHOD 1

120 credits attained at level 5.

120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking at all of your second and final year results.

Level 5 and level 6 grades are weighted at a ratio of 1:2

METHOD 2

120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking at all of your level 6 (final year) results.
