

# CONFUSED BY DEGREE CLASSIFICATION?

Use this method if you began your first year (Level 4) of studies from **September 2022**.

If you started your Level 4 studies before this date see our other leaflet on our website.

Out of following two methods, the best result is used:

## METHOD 1

120 credits attained at level 5.  
120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking at all of your second and final year results.

Level 5 and level 6 grades are weighted at a ratio of 1:2

## METHOD 2

120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking at all of your level 6 (final year) results.
