

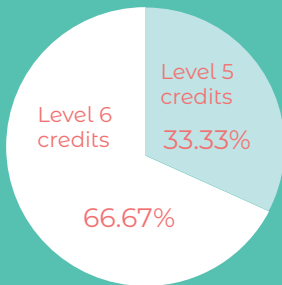
CONFUSED BY DEGREE CLASSIFICATION?

From August 2022 for all new students the University uses the following 2 different methods to classify an undergraduate degree with honours.

Out of following two methods, the best result is used:

METHOD 1

120 credits attained at level 5.
120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking all of your second and final year results.

Level 5 and level 6 grades are weighted on a ratio of 1:2

METHOD 2

120 credits attained at level 6.



Classifies your degree looking at all of your level 6 (final year) results.



Method 1 or 2	FIRST CLASS DEGREE	2:1 CLASS DEGREE	2:2 CLASS DEGREE
Minimum grade point average required	16.25	13.25	10.25
50% of level 6 graded credits must be at the following grade or above:	A-	B-	C-

Third class degree: Eligible for the award or an honours degree but does not achieve the requirements above.
