- Be ambassadors for the Students' Union and signpost students to all of the services we provide. You will be acting as a link between the SU and the new students during Welcome Week
- Encourage everyone to get involved, make friends, have fun and (most importantly) stay safe.

You will work as a team and should be alert to any problems that new students commonly experience and be aware of where they can go to get help and advice. You will be expected to provide clear and concise information, not advice or counselling.
