Volunteering hours can be recorded on your degree, meaning you can showcase your achievements when applying for jobs.

RAISE AND GIVE (RAG)

If you're passionate about helping good causes, getting involved with RAG is a great way to make a difference during your time at Worcester. Our student-led RAG Committee

will support you in fundraising for the charity of your choice, as well as hosting a range of activities for you to get involved with, like our annual Colour Run. Last year we raised over £35,000 and this year we want to raise even more!
