Positive


We will be positive about Worcester and what it can offer students, promoting how we can help and support them.


Student Trustees are vital to the board to ensure that we remain true to the charitable objectives, which are:

As a Student Trustee, you will be making a commitment to:

- Attend all meetings of the Board of Trustees (usually six in an academic year).
- Prepare for all meetings of the Board of Trustees by completing any actions required such as: reading relevant paperwork and consulting with other Trustees, Officers, or staff members.
- Participate in meetings as fully as possible; listening, debating, and seeking to make appropriate decisions (e.g finance or HR + remunerate).
- A willingness to make and stand by collective decisions, including those which may be unpopular, where these are in the best interests of WSU.
- Become familiar with WSU's governing document.
- Have demonstrable interest in and commitment to the democratic structures, values, and aims of WSU.

- Be willing to devote the time and effort required to fulfil the requirements of the role.
- Have an understanding and acceptance of the legal duties, roles, responsibilities, and liabilities of charity trustees.
- Be able to exercise sound, independent judgement.
- Have the ability to think creatively.
- Attend sub-committees and other meetings and events as required by the Board of Trustees.
- An active commitment to the value of diversity and to the removal of barriers to equality and involvement.
- The ability to understand the need for, and to maintain, confidentiality.
- The ability to manage challenging situations and handle competing priorities.

Student Trustees must be registered students at the University of Worcester and may not remain Trustees when they cease to be registered students.

Employees of WSU (other than Sabbatical Officers) may not be Student Trustees.

Student Trustees will be appointed for a period of up to two years, depending on the period for which they are registered a student
