7. Promote Inclusive, Fair & Empowered Communities

- Host a discussion, panel or event around equality, inclusion, or social justice
- Support campaigns tackling discrimination (e.g. LGBTQ+ rights, anti-racism, disability inclusion)
- Create a code of conduct for your society that promotes respect, accessibility and inclusion
