<b>Facts: What is the issue you're trying to address? What do we already know about this issue?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Business student representation requires improvement, with lower student engagement within the Business school due to factors such as timetabling, mental health and transport.</li> <li>• There are forums to discuss Business school related problems, such as the SSLC. These relate to academic teaching and modules.</li> <li>• There isn't a forum for discussing general problems facing Business students.</li> </ul>	
<b>Impacts: How does this issue affect students, and in what way? Is it negative?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Problems that are directly impacting Business students, and potentially worse for Business students, aren't appropriately discussed and represented.</li> <li>• Problems such as carparking, transport and mental health are not targeted, and solutions may not represent Business students fairly.</li> </ul>	
<b>Reacts: What would you like the Students' Union to do to address the issue? How do we need to take it forward?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This policy would mandate the Student Union to express support and lobby for the creation of a City Campus Development Board (BSDDB). The Student Union should express support for the CCDB in the form of conversations with relevant staff members, emails expressing support, etc.</li> <li>• This would discuss problems such as facilities, transport, carparking, etc.</li> <li>• Creation of the City Campus Development Board, bringing together relevant representatives from the University, participants could include;             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Staff representative from each department</li> <li>○ Student representative from each department</li> <li>○ Student representative from the Research School</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

  - The board would meet 4 times a year going forward.
  - This board would sit alongside the SSLC to discuss various topics that are relevant to student engagement, mental health, etc.
