- Currently we have 526 StARs, compared to last year this is slightly down but I do not see this as an issue. We have held two StAR forums on both timetabling and PAT, which have proved very productive. This has provided both myself and the University with feedback to build upon for the forthcoming academic year.
- Work with our partner colleges is proving difficult this academic year. Although we ran two
 training days, both based here and in Devon, the uptake of the offer was low and for us this
 was disappointing. It does however provide a foundation to build upon, changing ways we
 market the days in the future improving engagement.
- I have met with the individuals looking after technology enhanced learning within the University. After discussions, it is clear they are looking into different methods of lecture capture, which is promising. They will keep us updated on any progress.
