Summary:

I would like to find out if it is at all possible for the university to provide 'suitable' lockers for those who travel via motorcycle.

While there are lockers on site, they are not big enough to accommodate a motorcycle helmet.

Providing bigger lockers for those who ride motorcycles may help free up spaces across the number of often packed car parks on site.

Also, if adequate lockers were provided it may encourage more to travel in by motorcycle, further helping with freeing up more car park spaces.

Student Council Notes the Following Facts:

There are limited facilities for parking motorcycles on site and those that are in place do not have spaces to store helmets

There are lockers available that are more user friendly and that include spaces for helmets

There is a parking issue at the university and motorcycles parked in car parking spaces reduce the available space for cars



Student Council Holds the Viewpoint That:

- The University should review its provision for the parking of motorcycles
- This should include an increased provision with lockers that have space to store helmets
