# What work have you been undertaking towards your objectives since the last meeting? Please limit this to 5 items.

- New Year, New Soc Sophie started a campaign called "New year, New Soc" in Welcome Week. This allowed for students to suggest any society by filling in a postcard. Once a suggestion had been made, they will receive a free pair of socks (the first 13 are branded with the SU logo). If four or more people suggest the same one Sophie will set up an initial meeting.
