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This policy discussion led to a wider discussion around the accessibility of the website which included the ticketing function. It was agreed to, in addition to the proposals within the policy, establish a working group to review these accessibility issues with members of Student Council.

Student council expressed concern about the potential reduced student opportunities. Council suggested instead of the student trustee number going from 4 to 3, for that to stay at 4. The amended proposal was put forward for a vote and was approved with the amendments added.

12.0 Trustee Board Update

The Trustee Board met on 26th Nov and as well as receiving the normal reports and updates, including an update on Student Council, they:

- Signed off the annual accounts for the year ending July 2024 these can now be filed with the Charity Commission.
- Approved the annually updated Risk Register, Annual Statement of Legal Compliance, and Matrix of Delegated Responsibility. SW explained that the Matrix lays out what responsibilities are held by the Trustee Board, Student Council, SU Senior Management, and the University respectively in running the Union. The Risk Register details all the risks to the Union under various headings e.g. finance, HR, reputation, governance etc., and how we mitigate or try to reduce those risks, setting out what our biggest risks are. The Annual statement of Legal Compliance details how we comply with a range of legislation, e.g. that related to HR, health and safety etc in running the SU.
- Approved changes to Bye Laws 5 (Networks) and 6 (Societies, Clubs and Student Led Services) which had also gone through Student Council relating to the removal of committee members.
