	Academic and Welfare Advice service, that some students are not listed as exempt from
	paying council tax in cases where they could be exempt. For example if a student completed their 3-year undergraduate degree but completed retakes or unfinished
	modules in their 'fourth year', they would be registered as a part-time student and would
	no longer be listed as exempt from paying council tax.
