AL proposed an amendment to have the university be references for international students regarding housing (e.g. more of a moral guarantor than a financial guarantor).

6. **President Update**

AL provided a verbal update on their objectives as president involving cost of living campaign (community cupboard, SU drive, breakfast



club, sustainable period products), International hardship funding, improving campus facilities (such as prayer rooms) and the first university EDI forum.

7. Network/Society Updates

- Commuter network launched a group chat for students to communicate travel warnings, also held an open meeting.

- LGBTQ+ Network planning for Refreshers, Valentine's Ball, general email/admin to members about events locally.
 Considering creating a bi-weekly newsletter to promote local queer events and sending out emails for LGBTQ+ History Month in February.
- International Students Network holding an open meeting soon.

8. SU EDI Update

AL provided an update regarding SU EDI committee. During the previous meeting attendees spoke about W&I minutes and policies, the university EDI forum, the SU cultural calendar, the SU EDI action plan, feedback from core staff race awareness training, and the upcoming police forum.

9. **Sustainability**

AL confirmed the SU have been assigned a Green Impact Project Assistant, who is already doing great work. AL updated councillors that the SU will be looking at how to deliver on its sustainability work this year after unfortunately not receiving a university grant.

10. SU Leadership Elections

ARE provided the below introduction about the upcoming SU leadership elections;



Worcester Students' Union is a democratic organisation, which helps to ensure that the Union works for our students. This means that each year, the leadership of the SU (your Executive Officer Team) is determined by the student body through cross-campus elections. The University of Worcester has approximately 10,000 students and elected officers have responsibility for representing the interests of all these students. The following dates have been set for this year:

- Recommend a Friend will open on Monday 22nd January
- Nominations will open on Monday 5th February
- Nominations will close on Monday 19th February

ARE asked how the SU can help make the elections more representative and accessible to students.

In addition to answers given on Slido, students shared ideas on how to encourage underrepresented students to engage.

Ideas given involved using less complex language around elections, amount of inclusivity amongst staff and ensuring everyone has a fair chance.

Students were also asked how they wanted to be communicated with. Ideas given involved more face-to-face communication with students, social media and emails.

11. All Student Meeting

AL provided the following verbal update to councillors regarding the All Student Meeting.

The All Student Meeting is your chance to have your say in how your Students' Union represents and supports you during your time at Worcester. This meeting will provide you with reports on the year's events and the Union's plans, as well as asking you (our members) to approve its annual accounts and the organisations the Union has formal relationships (affiliations) with. The meeting is open to any member of the Union, so any current student can attend. It's important that this meeting is attended by as many students as possible so we're
