	Quoracy for meeting to go ahead explained again and reconfirmed that all Networks and Society Chairs have a vote in this meeting	
6.	President Update	
	Al has been re-elected as President and lately has been busy attending events such as Varsity, the CPR marathon organised by RAG Team and Paramedics. They attended the NUS National Conference (virtual attendance) where there was discussion of policies around providing support for international students.	
	AL has been working on Cost of living and Housing. Hardship funding is currently only available to home students and its challenging to get some movement on this. They are looking at other universities in the UK and what their practices are and use it as leverage to lobby Worcester University. AL has been improving space at Jenny Lind. They Officers had a walk round Jenny Lind and how the space can be made better. The Officers are hopeful to see some improvements made over the summer.	
	AL continues to work on the Community Cupboard initiative. Donations have slowed down and AL has applied for a community grant from the council to help run the community cupboard without relying on donations all the time. The SU is also an official foodbank	

	distributor. Students can access this through the Help and Advice Service. Foodbank vouchers can be a local foodbank not just ones in Worcester. AL sits on Health, Safety and Wellbeing committee and the University and the SU are now planning for Welcome Festival. After Network Week we are using feedback to create a Network Engagement plan.
7.	Network Update
	Disabled Students' Network (DSN) have been working on a Disability Awareness Campaign. Have been asking students, members, friends, people they know to submit their experiences of disability, neurodiversity, invisible illnesses, writing their stories and collating photos and videos. The DSN have tried to hold a couple socials, but turnout was low, but they are trying to organise one more social before the end of year and students leave for the summer. The British Sign Language (BSL) Society is also gaining traction and being set up after CW held a BSL workshop during Student Volunteers Week.
8.	SU EDI group update
	We annually review our EDI Policy in May and this updated version will be available for all to access on the website by the end of May.
9.	GISU and Sustainability Committee
	Our Green Impact Students' Union (GISU) Submission is due on the 4 th of May 2023 where we will be submitting all the work that we have been doing this year. In the last Sustainability Committee meeting, we discussed sustainability in terms of Varsity and materials used and how we sold all our t-shirts so have no excess stock. We discussed single use plastics and our continual efforts to avoid these at the SU particularly in the Hangar. We also discussed Digital carbon footprint and how we can reduce our footprints as staff such as deleting emails and how we can encourage students to do the same.
